Announcements:

- D. Timm requested coverage for courses on April 10 and 11 (315 and 355). C. Kuhrasch will cover the April 10 need. We will potentially find a graduate student to cover the other date.
- New cohort has been admitted and notified. Classifications have not been updated yet. Morgan will email Wyl Schuth to follow-up on notifications. There are currently 25 BSPE students and 5 PED with one special. Fall 2019 cohort has 7 students. Four more will be applying this semester and there are two additional possibilities. For the Fall 2020 cohort, there are currently 5 in the pipeline. Connor Brown has left school. We are starting to get more freshmen into the program than in the recent past.
- Physical Activity for Diverse Abilities Certificate has passed UAPC last month and will begin in the Fall of 2019. We are working on promotional materials.
- "Your UW Day" is February 15 – high school seniors who have applied/been admitted to UW would like to tour their potential majors. Could have up to 18 students – arranging to have them tour some labs and a potential PE activity.
- Some discussion regarding need for clarification on Kines 300 sections – Adapted Fitness vs. Physical Education.
- Day of Play February 8 – PE students will be helping RecSports. Keys to storage closets need to be accessible.
- McKenzie Miller named "Major of the Year" and has been invited to attend national SHAPE convention as part of her award package.
