Call to order

Approval of agenda/minutes

Agenda/Minutes approved via common consent.

Announcements

1. 116 EMS applications were reviewed, 100 were accepted with an average GPA of 3.47.
2. Cindy will be presenting at the Big 10 Leadership Conference next week; Dan Timm is attending the state WHPE convention.
3. Advising and orientation are completed. Two HPHE information sessions averaged about 10 attendees each including students and advisors. Certificate interest continues to grow; advisors at SoE are seeing lots of interest as well.

New Business

1. Kines 501 Course Change Proposal – Changing course title and content to better reflect needs of Health Minor, EMS and HPHE populations; adding LAS designation at request of Letters & Sciences to allow their students to double major in HPHE. Susan Andreae came in to answer questions about how course content has been adapted to fit more of an evidence-based approach. Kreg had minor suggestions for learning outcomes and consider changing the grading scale. Motion to approve/seconded. Passed unanimously.
2. Kines 123 Course Change Proposal – elective for HPHE; adding LAS designation at request of Letters & Sciences to allow their students to double major in HPHE. Motion to approve/seconded. Passed unanimously.
3. Kines 353 Course Change Proposal – elective for HPHE; adding LAS designation at request of Letters & Sciences to allow their students to double major in HPHE; adding HPHE to course requisite for easier enrollment. Motion to approve/seconded. Passed unanimously.
4. Kines 360 Course Change Proposal – adding certificate to requisite or easier enrollment. Motion to approve/seconded. Passed unanimously.
5. Kines 516 Course Change Proposal – Dropping COM B attribute; course will be for certificate only – changing requisite to reflect that. Motion to approve/seconded. Passed unanimously.
6. Kines 547 Course Change Proposal - elective for HPHE; adding LAS designation at request of Letters & Sciences to allow their students to double major in HPHE; adding HPHE to course requisite for easier enrollment. Motion to approve/seconded. Passed unanimously.
7. EMS GPA – Request to change exit GPA for EMS program to 2.5 to bring in line with the rest of the School of Education. Morgan explained that this would have affected 3 students in the last 3 years – all were underserved populations. It would currently affect 3 EMS students whose GPA's are below the current 2.75 continuation requirement. Motion to approve/seconded. Passed unanimously.
