Important updates from the Academic Staff Assembly:

The Academic Staff Assembly will have its fourth meeting of the year on Monday Dec 9. Several notable items are the agenda for this meeting:

- 1 UW System President Ray Cross and Vice Chancellor for Student Affairs Lori Reesor will both be giving presentations and answering our questions at this meeting. There has been no indication of what their presentation contains.
- 2 There will be a vote on the resolution regarding Assembly districts and the March-May 2020 Assembly meetings.

The new job titles become effective on March 1. This impacts the assembly districts (both member number and representatives). To maintain representation of everyone on March 2, the March meeting will have the same districting and representatives as it does now, while a new districting organization is implemented for the April and May meetings.

3 There will be a vote on the resolution objecting to the composition of the UW System President Search and Screen Committee.

A distinct lack of member diversity on the UW System President search and screen committee. Currently there are no faculty, academic staff, or university staff on the committee. We further object to the lack of outreach to faculty, academic staff, university staff, and students regarding the composition of the committee.
